## LEGAL NOTICE

On September 30, 2022, Liberty Utilities (Pine Bluff Water) Inc. filed an application with the Arkansas Public Service Commission for a change in the rates to be charged all classes of its customers. The request is based on a historic year ending December 31, 2021, with known and measurable changes through December 31, 2022, and seeks to cover increases in operating expenses and return on investment in plant investments, increases in expenses, and upgrades to facilities to service customers since the Company's last general rate adjustment. The total amount of the requested rate increase is \$5,717,158. The amount of the rate change from the various customer classes that would be produced based on the proposed changes to new schedules by customer class, the current and proposed rates by meter size and consumption per cubic feet are set out below.:
