Smart thermostats, smart appliances, and smart irrigation controllers all use technology to help you save.



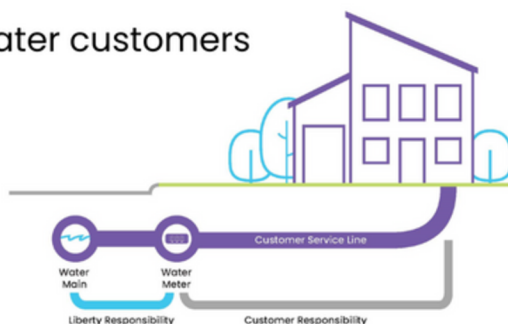
